Transform your garden from this...

An interesting solution when you are thinking of lawn for your garden is artificial grass.

While the natural lawn has maintenance needs all year round, with mowing, irrigation, fertilising and pest control, artificial grass is maintenance free, allowing you more time to enjoy your garden space.

Also, if you own a holiday property, artificial grass can be the perfect solution to reduce your monthly bills.

However, not all artificial grass is the same or has that natural look that is so important. Why? Because the design of the artificial grass has to be inspired by nature.

The grass fibre must mimic the colours, the shape and the structure of natural grass.

The similarities with natural grass result from the artificial grass yarn using the patented natural V shape fibre, formed by a robust core, the so-called "backbone" of the fibres, which maintains the upright stance of the grass.

There are two main types of artificial grass: with or without infill. The most common infilling used is sand.

The grass fibre must mimic the colours, the shape and the structure of natural grass

The function of the sand is to make the artificial turf heavier, and to surround the artificial grass fibres so that they remain upright.

The no-infill artificial grass has a frizzy brown and olive green fibre that replaces the sand and gives the grass its natural appearance.

The types using no infill are usually cheaper, particularly on installation costs.

Ensure you choose the most suitable type of artificial grass for your garden, balcony or roof terrace. &
